



Tool Box

A toolbox it is another inexpensive container to purchase and fill with interesting items. Most homes would have had a basic tool selection in their garage or under the stairs. You will need:

- Plastic PVC light weight toolbox

- PVC pipping, paint brushes, chains and locks, paint samples, a level or lightweight tape measure.
- Using the pen and paper make a sign asking, "what in the tool box?"
- Place in an area when people can pick it up or rummage inside.
